- Institutions know faculty are using AI in courses. The harder question is whether those courses are using AI well.
- AI tasks may appear innovative while still being weakly aligned to learning outcomes or unclear to students.
- General course-quality systems were not built to answer AI-specific questions about disclosure, verification, human oversight, and process evidence.

What CourseReady AI provides

- **ATQS:** a 24-criterion, six-domain framework built for course-level AI implementation.
- **AI-Ready Course Review:** a guided review with a written report, strengths/gaps analysis, and improvement priorities.
- **Recognition pathway:** AI-Ready Course and AI-Ready Course with Distinction, valid 18 months.
- **Institutional options:** department review, reviewer training, and campus implementation support.
